Accessories to the Comfort Keepers *SafetyChoice™* Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) are available to extend safety and security. They enhance home security, monitor doors/windows and detect movement in designated areas to protect loved ones who wander due to Alzheimer's or other dementia-related conditions.

When the accessories are activated, they send a wireless signal to the PERS unit, which then signals the PERS system to contact the central monitoring station for response.



DOOR & WINDOW CONTACTS

When a door or window is opened while the system is turned on, contacts set off an alarm in the home and send a signal to the central monitoring station. The station will call people on the subscriber's responder list to advise them of the situation. These units can be turned off during the day.



PRESSURE-SENSITIVE FLOOR MAT

This wireless floor mat may be placed next to a bed or other designated areas of the home. An alarm sounds when the mat is stepped on, signaling that a senior is out of bed or in an area that may be unsafe. In addition, a signal is sent to the central monitoring station to notify designated responders.



MOTION DETECTORS

Installed in a central area of the house, infrared motion detectors, when activated and tripped, signal the central monitoring station. The station will call the residence to verify whether the alarm was set off by an authorized person, then, if necessary, call designated responders. When used to monitor the movement of loved ones who wander, the system sends an alarm to the caregiver's computer. If the alarm system is not reset, the central monitoring station personnel will follow instructions established by the client. The motion detector can be turned off during the day.



SMOKE & CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS

In the event of an emergency, these detectors will signal the central monitoring station to dispatch the local fire department. Through the two-way communication feature of the PERS unit, voice contact will be made to make certain the client and caregiver know of the situation and leave the residence.
